

## My Next Steps Overview

Within Kuder Navigator®, students have access to an education and career planning timeline, *My Next Steps*. Essentially an interactive list of suggested tasks and activities (listed by grade level), *My Next Steps* guides students through the necessary steps to plan their education and future career. Each task or activity is linked to the appropriate section within the system and can be checked off the list as it is completed. To facilitate the most effective use of *My Next Steps*, a list of the tasks and activities for each grade level is below.

### 6th Grade Tasks

- Find out what your current work-related interests are by taking the Kuder Career Interests Assessment®.

### 10th Grade Tasks

- Explore occupations in favorite pathway(s) extensively and develop a short list of occupations that interest you.
- Decide or review selection of path to take after high school (work, military, on-the-job training, community college or technical school, four-year college).
- Review sample plans of study.
